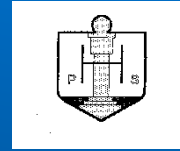

5. Pupil Council will lead an appeal for a donation of gifts to support local children at Christmas time. (More details to follow.)

We ask for your support to ensure your child does not bring Christmas cards into school to pass out to friends and staff. Instead, Class teachers will be helping the children learn about the tradition of sending Christmas wishes and together they will find alternative ways for them to express and share their Christmas wishes and messages with their friends.
